- This variance approval may be revoked for failure to follow manufacturer's instructions or failure to seek proper repair as needed for machines using the shake and sundae dairy mix.

Machine instruction manuals, NSF testing and rating information, and McDonald's standard operating procedures may serve as supporting documentation during these discussions.
